This course is a basic introduction to the world of Business Continuity Management (BCM). It is designed as a first step for newcomers to the subject of BCM and for those for whom BCM may be a part of their role or responsibilities who need to have a good understanding of the subject. It provides the beginner with the basic knowledge and understanding of the building blocks required for developing or maintaining a robust BCM Programme and gives those individuals with a BCM related role or responsibility a comprehensive overview of the discipline.

This course covers all six elements of the BCM Lifecycle as shown below and is based on global good practice as described in the Business Continuity Institute's Good Practice Guidelines and the international standard for Business Continuity ISO 22301.

**Course Objectives**

The objectives of this training course are to provide participants with the ability to:

- Understand the world of BCM;
- Understand how to structure the BCM Lifecycle process;
- Apply the methods available to conduct a BCM; and
- Utilise the information from the BC to design the most appropriate continuity recovery strategies.
